 - Gates on Apron 1
 - Finger

• Gate Changes

- o There shall be no gate changes

• Having Staff (BFRS) on during a late departure

- Clarification needs to be made on the timeframe on how long BFRS should stay after a private flight has departed.
 - 15 Minutes is towers recommendation

• Reporting Accidents with injury
