

Product Alert – Honeywell Eye Protection

Recently Aecon has discovered that some Honeywell eye protection has been supplied that is not currently CSA approved.

Changes to CSA Z94.3 Eye and Face Protectors came into effect in September 1, 2017. This required manufactures to retest their product to the new standard. During this transition, any product manufactured after this date that has not been tested will not contain the CSA marking.

What can be used:

Any product that contains the CSA logo has been tested and approved to either the previous standard or the new standard based on date of manufacture.

Markings will be on the packaging and either the frame or lens of the eye protection.

What can't be used:

Any product that does not contain the CSA logo must be removed from use. The glasses or packaging may contain the standard Z94.3 or statements such as "meets the requirements of Z94.3".

Action Required:

Any product identified without the CSA logo is to be removed from service and returned to the supplier for exchange.
